SERIES OVERVIEW. The undercurrent of the entire book of Galatians in one word is this: grace. It's about the real gospel versus a fake gospel. While many are caught trying to earn their way to God, he's telling us to look up. He's waiting for us to stop trying to earn his love and start learning to live from being loved.

QUESTIONS:

- What you believe should change who you are. What fact or idea has ever changed you? How are you different because of what you believe? How do your beliefs change the way you live your life?
- In what ways does knowing about Jesus change the way you treat people? How does your relationship with Jesus impact your friendships?
- What weighs heavier on you—what others think of you or what you think of yourself? How does knowing what God thinks of you override both?
- When you understand who you are in Jesus, you're ready to start helping others. Why is knowing your true identity so important when it comes to loving and helping others?
- In Galatians chapter 6, Paul instructs believers to bear each other's burdens. How is that different than trying to fix what's wrong? What crucial character traits does Paul give in Galatians 6:1-3 for helping or restoring others? How can you be more empathetic towards those who need help?
